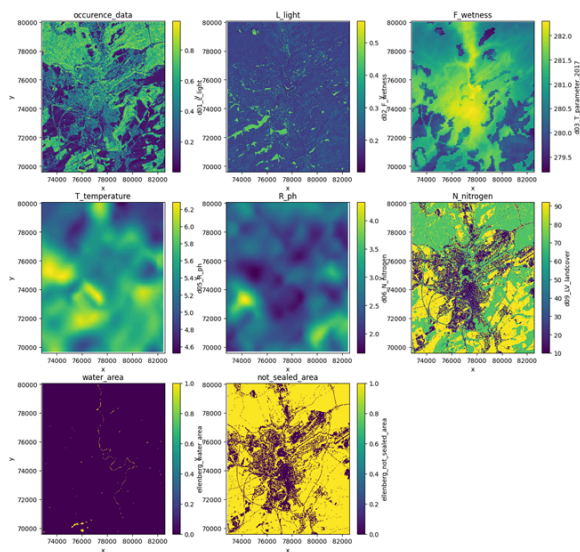


Enhancing environmental data sharing: Policy brief

As part of the Fairicube project, Space4Environment has developed a compelling Storymap of Invasive Species in Luxembourg.
